India Boost Security Spending in the Run Up to the 2010 Commonwealth Games

In the run up to this year's XIX Commonwealth Games 2010 to be held in New Delhi from the 3 - 14 October, India has embarked on a massive boost in security expenditure.

It is an unfortunate fact of life today that sports events are now in the frontline of the global war against terror, as was demonstrated recently by the attack on the Togo soccer team in Angola during the African Cup of Nations, which left 3 people dead and eight others wounded. And closer to home in Lahore last March, 12 gunmen ambushed the Sri Lankan cricket team on the way to play a Test Match, killing six policemen escorting the Sri Lankans and their driver.

These attacks were not dissimilar in their modus operandi to the Mumbai attack last year which has had the effect of strengthening the resolve of the Indian Government to ensure the security of The Commonwealth Games. Indeed it has been reported that over Rs100 crores (US\$20 million) is being spent on purchasing security equipment including X-ray scanners, door frames and hand held metal detectors, communication systems and CBRN equipment.

In addition to upgrading the security of venues, the security of air and sea ports, hotels, mass transportation and borders are also under review and enhanced security systems are currently being evaluated and will be purchased to meet specific requirements in the near future.

Against this background India has embarked on the largest procurement programme anywhere in the world. Global Security India 2010 will therefore provide a unique platform for the Homeland Security Industry to promote their products and services to this important market.
